

Needlework

Department Rules:

1. Articles entered should not have the name of the exhibitor visible, otherwise article cannot be judged. Exhibitor's name may be covered with masking tape.
2. Every article which is to be hung must be mounted & ready to hang, with wire or hanger attached.
3. Open work should be displayed on stiff-colored paper. Do not display on cellophane.
4. Collections of small items must be mounted securely on a base no larger than 12" x 18".
5. A set (pictures, etc.) to be entered should be mounted together. One single part of the set not to exceed 12" x 18".
6. Articles made for competition must be the work of the exhibitor, completed in the last 1 ½ years and not previously entered in the Fair.
7. Be careful that your exhibit is ready to be shown - clean and well presented for the judges.
8. Follow the Premium List closely to enter in the best possible category for your entry.
9. Exhibitors may enter as many items as desired in each class; however, duplicative entries in the opinion of the department superintendent will not be allowed (e.g. two 10" and over linen samplers, two cross stitched pillows).
10. Anyone may enter the Open Class.

Teachers, judges and professionals MUST enter the Open Class. The Open Class is not eligible for Special Awards.

Suitability of Materials.....	10
Finishing and Mounting.....	20
Total Points.....	100
