NOTICE:

Dear Horsemen,

We welcome you back to the races at the Elko County Fair. There are some new requirements and rules so please read the following:

Upon the recommendations of the Nevada Department of Agriculture's State Veterinarian Dr. J.J. Goicoechea and the Nevada Gaming Control Board's State Veterinarian Dr. Richard Scott, all horses entered to participate at approved pari-mutuel race tracks in Nevada must first provide a negative Piroplasmosis test. Piroplasmosis is caused by Theleria equi and has emerged in the racing industry in recent years. A negative cELISA test within the last 12 months for Theleria equi will be required for all race horses. No horse will be allowed to enter unless a current health certificate, negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia, and a negative test for Theleria equi are on file with the racing secretary.

The health certificate is valid for 30 days when it is made by a licensed veterinarian in the state where the examination was completed. Equine Infectious Anemia and Piroplasmosis test are valid for 12 months from the date of sample collection. For more information please contact the State of Nevada Agriculture Elko Field Office at (775)738-8076.

Registration Papers- All registration papers and foal certificates must be deposited with the Racing office and show bona fide ownership on the papers before the horses will be allowed to start. Please do not bring registration papers to the office during the time reserved for entries. If possible send a list of horses you (or list all on your stall reservation form) are bringing via email to the Fairboard secretary prior to shipping to help in speeding up the entry process and printing of the programs.

Owners and trainers are cautioned to check carefully the eligibility of all horses in their care prior to entry in the races and claiming of allowances on said entries. Under the universal rules of racing, the trainer is ultimately responsible for the weight and eligibility of horses entered in the races during the Elko County Fair Race Meet. Ineligible entry of horses will be dealt with by the Board of Stewards.

The Stewards reserve the right to withdraw or scratch any horse which in their opinion is entered out of his racing class.

ENTER TO RACE: THERE WILL BE NO SCRATCH TIME.

Jockeys must be named at time of entry. Should no jockey be named by the end of the draw each day, the stewards shall name one.

Equipment changes must be approved by the paddock Judge and must be made at time of entry.

The trainer is responsible for an entry withdrawal before the scheduled time of closing. If he/she fails to do so, the only way the entry may be withdrawn is with permission of the Board of Stewards. In the event of a short field, it will be at the discretion of the Board of Stewards whether the horse may be withdrawn.

ALL RACES PICKED UP BY EQUIBASE, TRU-FORM PUBLICATIONS OR ANY OTHER CHARTING ORGANIZATION RECOGNIZED BY THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD WILL COUNT TOWARDS ELIGIBILITY WHEN ENTERING AND CLAIMING OF WEIGHT ALLOWANCES, INCLUDING THOSE ON THE IDAHO FAIR CIRCUIT.

NO OUTSIDE BULK SHAVINGS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE DUMPED ON THE GROUNDS. SHAVINGS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE FROM THE ELKO COUNTY FAIRBOARD.

ATTENTION ALL TRAINERS

YOU MUST BE ABLE TO FULLY LICENSE YOUR OWNERS BY HAVING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION PRIOR TO THE FIRST RACE OF THE DAY. OWNER NAME, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DATE OF BIRTH AND ADDRESS. Owner's silks must be declared and described at time of entry— no exceptions.

Any purse monies not collected; by person or persons earning them; before December 31st of the current year earned will be relinquished back to the Elko County Fairboard for future year purses. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The Nevada Gaming Control Board has adopted additional regulations pertaining to the health and medication of horses, consistent with the requirements of Regulation 30.404, testing procedures will be broadened to include the detection of anabolic steroids.

Time trials for stakes races will run on the first weekend. Each time trial shall consist of not more than ten (10) head in Quarter Horse stakes and not more than nine (9) head in the Thoroughbred Stakes. Trials and Finals shall be contested under the same conditions.

The fastest ten qualifiers shall qualify for the finals of the Quarter Horse Stakes based upon a time basis from the trials. A list of qualifiers will be posted in the Racing Office at the completion of the trials. In all cases, the decision of the Board of Stewards shall be final.

The nine finalists for the finals of Thoroughbred Stakes shall be selected based upon placing from the trials. Trials for the Thoroughbred Stakes do not have to be run consecutively on trial day and may be separated with the permission of the Nevada Gaming Control Board and the Board of Stewards prior to the draw for the trials.

In the case of a tie, horses shall draw lots to determine who will run in the finals. Should a mechanical failure occur with the electric timer during the running of the trials, or if in the opinion of the Board of Stewards, track conditions should materially change during the running of the trials that would give an unfair advantage, the finalists shall then be selected and determined by means determined by the Board of Stewards which has been determined as most equitable under the circumstances.

Should any or all of the front gates of the starting gate fail to open during the trials or finals, the horse or horses shall be declared as "non starter" and no liability will be incurred beyond the return of all nominating, sustaining or penalty payments made in the name of said horse for the race entered. The decision of the Board of Stewards shall be final in all matters.

Nominating, sustaining and penalty payments are accepted only on the condition that all persons nominating or starting a horse in the trials or finals agree to abide by the decision of the stewards. If any part of an entry should be disqualified during the running of a race, it may disqualify the entire entry. Entries in the trials owned in part or in whole by the same owner and trained by the same trainer will be split apart if at all possible.

Purse Distribution: all horsemen's payments (original nominating, sustaining and penalty payments, less office administration fee, less jockey fees and insurance, together with the added money, will be paid as follows):

10 horse field: 40%/20%/10%/8%/6%/5%/4%/3%/2%/2%

Disclaimer: Horses who have started in the trials and later are found to have used any illegal medication as prescribed by Nevada State Racing Rules, will not be allowed to run in the finals. Nominating, sustaining & penalty payments will not be returned in the event these stakes races are not approved by AQHA, regardless of the reason for lack of approval. NOTICE TO HORSEMEN continued!

Agents– All agents will be required to be licensed as such per the Nevada NRS Statue. **Due to Insurance Reasons:** children will not be allowed to be on horseback or drive golf carts. Parents/Guardians are absolutely responsible for all children's actions.

Trucks and cars will be permitted in the stable area after training hours only to make deliveries, trailers must be approved by the race office for certain areas only. All Trainers will be responsible for the area surrounding their stable no weeds or trash please. Fire and Emergency vehicle access MUST be available at all times.

ONLY licensed personnel will be allowed to handle horses on the Race Track or in the paddock or stable area. The trainer is responsible for his horses and the proper licensing of all personnel handling the horses in his/her charge. No unlicensed person is allowed in paddock area from 20 minutes before first post to completion of last race.

ALL RACE HORSES HAVE TO BE SADDLED IN THE PADDOCK AREA NO HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO SADDLE IN THE BARN AREA!!

All pony riders must wear helmets and long sleeve shirts (You must provide your own). Outriders are not allowed to pony horses.

No dogs allowed in paddock area during race times from 20 minutes before first post to completion of last race. .

Horses will not be allowed to gallop or pony the wrong direction on the race track.

Pony horses must leave adequate space for horses galloping or working towards the inside of the race track.

Livestock identification and Animal Health requirements upon entering Nevada:

You are required to have a brand inspection, health certificates and current Coggins certificate. Nevada recognizes EIA as current if done within the past 6 months. You as owners or trainers are responsible for the health, safety and welfare of all horses entering the Elko County Fairgrounds.

****All horses must be tattooed prior to starting. All horses need to be tattooed prior to coming to the Elko County Fair. We DO NOT guarantee a tattooer will be on the premises.**

BOOKKEEPING NOTICE: Trainers and Owners are asked to update their information with the racing and fair office. No check will be issued without the owner's social security number or tax identification number. This is the trainers and owners responsibility to get this information to the racing/fair office, no information no check! It is not our responsibility to run down owners or trainers after the races are over to make sure all purses are paid. **Any and all purse funds not collected by December 31st of the current racing year will be relinquished back to the Elko Co Fair Board for future purse monies. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

All first place checks will be held until tests are cleared, which could be as long as a month after the last race day.

Prior to putting in a claim for a horse the owner or their designated representative must insure that all funds incurred with claiming a horse are on deposit at the race office prior to race running.

NO OUTSIDE BULK SHAVINGS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE DUMPED ON THE GROUNDS. SHAVINGS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE FROM THE ELKO COUNTY FAIRBOARD.
