

Exhibitors Selling Market Fryer Pen at the Elko County Livestock Show & Sale 2021



1. A pen of fryer chickens will consist of three pullets and/or cockerels of any breed; however, it is strongly suggested that meat breeds such as Cornish or Cornish cross be chosen over egg laying and dual-purpose breeds.
2. Weight limits at Fair time are set at a minimum of 3 pounds per bird with no maximum.
3. It is recommended that birds be hatched a minimum of 6 weeks and a maximum of 8 weeks prior to the show depending on the breed of bird and nutrition program chosen.
4. The pen of fryers must be in the participant's possession by no later than **July 31**. The pen will be judged on meat type, uniformity, condition and conformation. The pen must receive a live ribbon placing of red or better to sell at the auction.
5. Fryers can be home hatched or purchased; however, in all cases they must be home raised and cared for by the participant. ECFBLC must approve any exceptions.
6. All broiler buyers will complete a purchase agreement at the Sale and may choose to resale the broilers or pick up the meat from the processor.

All Market Fryer Pen need to have proof of possession by **July 31st**, by way of sending in this form and **photos** of fryer pen via email (ElkoCoFairLivestockShowandSale@gmail.com) or postage mail (PO Box 2067, Elko, NV 89803) to Elko County Fair Board Livestock Committee. All Market Fryer Pen should be in exhibitors care and on a feed program by **July 31**.
