Action Item

Silver State Trade Show:

Dawn Leyva wanted to come and talk about co-sponsoring the Silver State Trade show during Cowboy Poetry. She can't afford the rent and needs a lot of help. In the past we have done it and she just collected the rent, did the set up and just gave the fairboard the profits. She only had 11 booths this year, 2018 she had 25. She is working with Tom Lester to get a bus to go around and take people to the different venues. She will start recruiting in July for vendors. We would have to supply the building (donate) and advertising, all the banners are already made. She charges \$260.00 for vendors. There are 8 total venues during the poetry that will benefit from the bus that would go around town to all the venues. Giovanni Puccinelli made a motion to co-sponsor the silver state trade show and Amelia Wakley seconded all approved.

2023 Elko Co Fair Planning:

Chairman Tony Buzzetti reported the concert stuff is not going well. There are a couple of different reasons, but the main reason is the airport is a problem with flights in and out of Elko. If they come into Salt Lake, they will need to rent more vehicles which raises the prices. The people we have gotten to talk to, the price is just not feasible. Amelia suggested finding a mega donor for a concert that would help us offset our main cost and bring in a bigger name.

Roy Elsner stated that the school schedule might conflict with our schedule, but nothing has been set in stone yet.

Grounds Reports and ARPA Improvements Update:

Grounds Manager JT Taravella reported they had a meeting with Lostra Bros, they have plans drawn up for the bathrooms. Giovanni reported on the drawings, on the plans and trying to keep the costs down. Plumbing is going to be the biggest cost as we are going to move them. At the next meeting we will have an estimated cost too. JT is trying to get all the snow out of the arena and wants to start on the bridge soon. The Iron company next to PacVan is donating the iron to seal the bridge together. The zero-turn lawn mower 42" IFA \$3,500.00 Cal Ranch \$3,100.00 and Home Depot \$3,500.00. He has worked on getting quotes from Cal Ranch, 5th Gear and Empower Sports for a new utility vehicle.

The stall panels we have Boss Tanks and Hoof Beats 30 pens 15 on each side. And 3 more tire water troughs for the cattle pens. We will go to the county with the utility vehicle, pens, and troughs quotes.

Discussion on the barn area sound system and the quote they got. JT will go back to him and ask what they can do for the \$15,000-\$16,000 range. Nothing else to report.
