

Exhibitors Selling Market Rabbit Pen at the Elko County Livestock Show & Sale 2026



1. A pen of fryer chickens will consist of three pullets and/or cockerels of any breed; however, it is strongly suggested that meat breeds such as Cornish or Cornish cross be chosen over egg laying and dual-purpose breeds.
2. Weight limits at fair time are set at a minimum of 3 pounds per bird with no maximum.
3. It is recommended that birds be hatched a minimum of 6 weeks and a maximum of 8 weeks prior to the show depending on the breed of bird and nutrition program chosen.
4. The pen of fryers must be in the participant's possession by no later than **July 24**. The pen will be judged on meat type, uniformity, condition and conformation. The pen must receive a live ribbon placing of red or better to sell at the auction.
5. Fryers can be home hatched or purchased; however, in all cases they must be home raised and cared for by the participant. ECFBLC must approve any exceptions.

All Market Fryer Pens need to have proof of possession by **July 31st**, by way of sending in this form and **photos** of fryer pen via email (ElkoCoFairLivestockShowandSale@gmail.com) to Elko County Fair Board Livestock Committee.

Registration for the Livestock Show & Sale will open July 1st and close August 8th.
