Meeting Minutes from the Regular monthly meeting February 11, 2026. Justin McDermott moved to approve the meeting minutes, Jay Dalton seconded the motion, all approved.

Giovanni Puccinelli is running for Mayor of Elko and would like the Fairboard endorsement.

Fairgrounds Improvements / Budget Requests: *For Possible Action Item*

Discussion on the bids and items for the list. Take out the backhoe, relocating the pedestals and the striping chute to make the total for \$40,595.71 to ask the county for funds.

Justin Wines, in the future he would like to spend the money with a firm to make a strategic plan for the fairgrounds and get some capital projects going. Justin McDermott made the motion to go ask for \$40,595.00 for funds for projects selected. Justin Wines seconded. All approved.

2026 Elko Co Fair Planning: *Action Item*

- Veterans' day at the fair: Justin McDermott discussed the day selected for military day. The first Saturday would be the best day. We will do a race that day with 6 horses \$10,000 allowance race for military race with one horse for each branch of the military. We will plan on a flyover, with veterans on the track during the color guard. Free admission to veterans on that day.
- Livestock Committee: Rebecca Dohl resigned from the Goat position. Miranda Preston has volunteered to take the position. We have several new clubs joining and several market animals. Junior Ambassadors need approved as well. Judges they are working on. Jay Dalton moved to appoint Miranda Preston for goat Justin McDermott seconded all approved. Jay Dalton moved to approve, and Justin McDermott seconded Junior Ambassadors recommend Brooklyn Chappell, Landon Tourrelli, Hannah Nelson, Dallas McGarr all approved.
- Other fair Business: Karen Hoem suggested Friday Sept 4th they would like to stay open till 12:00 and throw an afterparty 80's. on the busy nights snacks for people who have been drinking a lot would be a good idea. It isn't available later and would like to stock snacks down there at the cowboy bar to sell or provide. Wants to do the little buckaroo bar again, the bloody mary bar and create a Facebook social media following for the cowboy bar to promote it.
